


Marster Class on ECPR & MCS – 1st Time in India:

Master class was conducted during 19th ECMO training course at Ridhi Vinayak Critical Care and Cardiac Centre, Mumbai. On 4th June 2024 was virtual sessions of Master Class on ECPR & MCS. On 10th June 2024 was demonstration and hands on off Master Class on ECPR & MCS. Delegates were divided into 5 Teams & after initial Demo of how to do ECPR by faculty, each team performed ECPR on 5 different mannequins (including Obese & Paediatric) by themselves at different location (ER, MICU, PICU, Wards & Cath Lab) at the same time. ECPR call to ECMO flow time was 16 mins done by faculty (during Demo) & was 30 – 40 mins by delegates. (Note One team (in Cath Lab) done ECPR with Roller Pump & One team (in MICU) done ECPR on morbidly Obese mannequin). This was followed by combined debriefing with all team emphasizing the advantage & difficulties of ECPR in different locations.

CASE:

A 9 years old girl presented with short febrile illness associated with coughing & difficulty in breathing alone with rapidly progressive hypoxemia. She needed intubation & ventilator support, noted massive pulmonary hemorrhage. Her CT thorax S/O diffuse alveolar hemorrhage. He was kept on HFOV. Despite of all conventional aggressive measure – persistent hypoxemia was noted. Eventually V-V ECMO was initiated with family consent. She was diagnosed Sero-negative vasculitis and managed as per vasculitis protocol. Needed multiple blood & its products. She responded to Plasmapheresis. Gradually hemodynamics and hypoxia recovered and she was weaned from V-V ECMO support on rest ventilator settings. After 1 month of hospitalization, she was successfully discharged home.

Quiz Answer (of Page No 4): Limb ischemia is common after arterial cannulation during ECPR. Even with a lesser size of arterial cannulas, it can happen. So, after the flow is established, we should put a distal perfusion cannula (DPC) within 4 hours, either percutaneously under USG guidance or by surgical cut-down and to be connected to the side connector of the arterial cannula as soon as possible. This will keep both lower limbs equally perfused.

As in ECPR time is an essence, to decrease Low flow time & the next priority is to evaluate cause & treat it so as to recover heart at earliest. DPC can be deferred for 4 hours but it should not be further delayed than that.





ECMO INDIAN DATA 2024

ECMO INDIA STATISTICS

No of Institute participated (data submission) – 17, most of them submitted data from 2021 onwards except for 3 who submitted data from 2010

Overall 591cases reported from 2010 to 2024 with overall survived ECLS 41% & Survived to discharge 37%


Maximum cases reported are Adult respiratory ~ 55% followed by adult cardiac ~ 35% followed by Paediatric respiratory ~ 6% followed by adult ECPR ~ 3%.

Neonatal respiratory & Paediatric cardiac cases are less than 0.5% while no cases reported of neonatal cardiac & neonatal & Paediatric ECPR

Survival was seen maximum in Paediatric respiratory \sim 59% followed by neonatal respiratory 50%, followed by adult cardiac 43% followed by adult respiratory 39% followed by adult ECPR \sim 16%

Around 45% of the cardiac ECMO cases were secondary to Aluminum phosphide poisoning with survival rate $\sim 56\%$


